CADKEY Hosts First National DataCAD Dealer Conference

DataCAD dealers from across the U.S.A. participated in CADKEY's first National DataCAD Dealer Conference at International Headquarters in Manchester, Connecticut, hosted by the A/E/C Product Group, September 11-12, 1989.

The meeting presented CADKEY's plans to develop, support, and distribute the DataCAD product line through a network of expert dealers. The presentations and discussions included sales, marketing, product development, quality control, technical support, third-party developments, and educational programs. Dealers' questions led to lively discussions regarding advertising, trade shows, and training.

Dealers asked if current CADKEY or DataCAD dealers will automatically become new dealers in the other product line. In reply, Gary Delius emphasized CADKEY's concept of distributing through expert dealers. It will be possible for a single dealership to carry both the CADKEY and DataCAD product lines, but to do so, a dealership must qualify for each product line individually. The dealer must be knowledgeable both in the mechanical-engineering arena and in the architecture, engineering, and construction industry to qualify to handle both CADKEY and DataCAD products.

Announcements included special promotions, new pricing for DataCAD products, new pricing for DataCAD maintenance, and new bundling of DataCAD products. These apply to the United States and Canada.

Special DataCAD promotions effective immediately for 90 days include these bundled packages: DataCAD + DC Modeler, and DataCAD + DC Modeler (site license).

Special DataCAD promotions effective October 1 for 90 days include Velocity and these bundled packages: DC Modeler + Velocity, and DataCAD + DC Modeler + Velocity.

DataCAD 128™ Unveiled

CADKEY introduced a new product, DataCAD 128TM. DataCAD 128 is an educational package that is also available to dealers for promotional purposes.

DataCAD 128 is a fully functional version of DataCAD, Version 3.6e with a maximum drawing-file size of 128K bytes. DataCAD 128 includes a fully functional copy of DC Modeler and several macros, such as Viewmaster, that do not exceed 128K in size. DataCAD 128 does **not** include the DataCAD AEC macro or its associated symbol libraries, with the exception of the Furniture symbols such as Tables and Chairs.

DataCAD 128 is a product intended for educational or trial use. It is offered <u>as is</u>, without warranty, technical support, or program updates. DataCAD 128 is shipped with a copy of <u>DataCAD For The Architect</u> only. Site licenses are **not** available for this product.

Ted Heywood, Director of the A/E/C Products Group, said: "We encourage dealers to use DataCAD 128 agressively to gain new exposure for DataCAD. We have entered a new phase in developing DataCAD. Our aggressive pricing, bundling, and new product announcements provide the means to increase DataCAD sales dramatically in the next several months. This is an exciting time for CADKEY and our dealers in the A/E/C marketplace. We look forward to working with you to raise the profile of this outstanding product set. The CADKEY Advantage works for you."

The MicroCADD Academic Award recognizes an individual from the academic community who has made a significant contribution to microCADD education. The MicroCADD Application Award recognizes an organization for its unique or innovative application of microCADD technology. The MicroCADD Award for the Advancement

of Computer Graphics recognizes an individual who has been instrumental in the development and acceptance of microCADD within her/his company.

CADKEY RENDER™ To Debut At AUTOFACT

CADKEY, INC. will introduce CADKEY RENDERTM at AUTOFACT in Detroit, Michigan, on October 31, 1989. CADKEY RENDER uses CADLTM (CADKEY's Advanced Design Language) to integrate geometric data created in CADKEY 3TM with the PhotoRealistic RenderMan InterfaceTM. The PhotoRealistic RenderMan Interface is the 3-D, photorealistic, scene-description, software protocol developed and marketed by Pixar of San Rafael, California. "This is a real feather in CADKEY's cap," said Bill Kolomyjec, Pixar's RenderMan evangelist. "At least six CAD software companies have announced plans to develop rendering software using the RenderMan interface. CADKEY is the first to introduce a commercial product."

Using Computer Graphics World's definition (July, 1988, and July, 1989 issues) the RenderMan interface is a collection of procedures for transferring scene descriptions from a modeling program to a rendering program to produce photorealistic output. "The RenderMan interface allows a CAD company to make its own advanced-imaging product," said Bob LaRochelle, CADKEY RENDER's Project Manager. "RenderMan's photorealism is another reason for true 3-D."

In addition to applications in art, animation, architecture, marketing, engineering and science, CADKEY RENDER and Pixar's PhotoRealistic RenderMan can contribute significantly to manufacturers of consumer products. "The manufacturer can see a photorealistic model of a product," LaRochelle continued. "He/she gets to make decisions about materials, colors and textures before incurring the expense of building a prototype." "This form of previsualization," Bill Kolomyjec added, "is really a soft prototype. It cannot be done in 2-D. 3-D is essential."

"Together with CADKEY 3 and CADKEY SOLIDSTM," Clive Thomas, CADKEY's Product Manager, said, "CADKEY RENDER provides an effective PC solution for industrial design at a small fraction of the cost of a workstation-based alternative. The same part files created during the design process can be used as the basis for machining operations, using products from CADKEY's third-party developers."

CADKEY/386TM, a full 32-bit implementation of CADKEY 3TM (Version 3.52), enhances performance by allowing a user to address up to 4 gigabytes of memory.
