On March 14, 1990, the **Canadian Automated Manufacturing Show** held in Montréal, Québec, Canada, provided a spectacular example of the power and speed of CADKEY<sup>(R)</sup> in manufacturing. **TECHNIDUSTRIE**, a Canadian CAD/CAM association, sponsored a seminar on CAD/CAM/CIM, including a demonstration of the complete design-through-manufacturing process. The demonstration included an open competition in which a number of companies participated, including CISIGraph showing STRIM 100<sup>TM</sup>, ICAM Technologies showing AutoCAM<sup>TM</sup>, and Lemire & Habrich/IBM showing CATIA<sup>(R)</sup>. Centres Canadiens CAO/FAO, Inc. used CADKEY and SmartCAM<sup>TM</sup>.

The association developed a benchmark part which included a complex surface blend composed of multiple fillets. Each participant was supposed to create the part "live" in front of

show attendees. But, as it turned out, Centres Canadiens was the only participant that actually demonstrated live. Moreover, Centres Canadiens was the only participant able to produce the complete part.

The complex surface blend (in machining terms, a gradient with a corner radius blend) stumped the competition, but Applications Engineer Sylvain Trudel completed the project, design to manufacture, in just one hour. The project was later shown in their booth for added impact.

Ron Lepore, CAD/CAM R&D Coordinator at Vanier College, Montréal, confirmed that CADKEY and SmartCAM were the only PC-based software entry in the competition. "This competition demonstrated that a PC-based CAD and CAM package can outperform a mini- or mainframe-based system," Ron said.

Jean-Marc Fillion, President of Centres Canadiens CAO/FAO, credited his company's success to CADKEY and SmartCAM's speed and flexibility that gave them the confidence to do it *live*.
